Fire Drills

Regina Catholic Schools are required to now have six fire drills throughout the school year. We have already practised three fire drills in the Fall and we will be conducting three more in the Spring. As we are once again sharing some of our basement classrooms with Archbishop M.C. O'Neill High School, we run all of drills in conjunction with them. Our teachers reviewed the procedures for fire

drills with their students prior to the first school drill.

Reverse Evacuation Drill

During the Fall and Spring we will also be practicing a Reverse Evacuation Drill in which we call students in from the playground from their recess break. This is practiced to prepare for the event of a danger entering our playground area (an unwanted visitor, a stray animal, etc.).



Lockdown Drills

It is also a requirement of Regina Catholic Schools that Lockdown procedures are practiced two times throughout each school year. A Lockdown could be called by the administration any time there may be an immediate threat to the safety of the school. Once

again, we practice this drill in conjunction with O'Neill.

Classroom teachers will explain the procedures to their students and will have a mock classroom practice prior to the first school lockdown practice that will occur the week of November 6. Students are always informed of lockdown practices so that we do not create fear or panic in our students.
