Dear Parents and Guardians,

This fall we are continuing our initiative designed to celebrate positive school behaviour. School-Wide Positive Behaviour Interventions and Supports (SWPBIS) is a framework that engages staff with all students in reinforcing positive behaviours.

An Expectation Matrix has been developed by staff to promote positive behavioural expectations in different areas of the school. Students are encouraged to demonstrate positive participation, awesome attitudes, working together and staying safe throughout the day.

All staff will acknowledge positive behaviours by providing students with verbal praise and feedback. In addition, positive behaviours may be identified by giving students PBIS tickets. Tickets will be collected and draws will be made at weekly assemblies.

The behaviour matrix will be taught and practiced at assemblies and in classrooms with all students. It is posted in the hallway outside the office. Each room will also have a posted copy, and we have posted one on the website.

To assist in gathering information about the needs of our student body, we will be collecting data around current student behaviours. Please note as we move forward, teacher data about individual students and their classroom profiles will be shared only with school administration. Administration will compile the general data (school trends and progress over the year) to share with staff and with parents through the year.

Our hope is that we can promote school expectations in a positive and proactive way and encourage student engagement by building staff-student relationships.
